

Authentic Kyudo experience

Katsuura is home to the International Budo University, which focuses on education and research related to martial arts, physical education, and sports, and the Nippon Budokan Training Center, a facility located nearby that is operated by the Nippon Budokan. Located on a hill overlooking the Pacific Ocean adjoining Katsuura and Minamiboso, this is a training facility for martial arts enthusiasts as well as a general accommodation facility that can be used by members of the general public. In collaboration with the International Budo University and the Nippon Budokan Training Center, the Katsuura City Tourism Association offers a "hands-on Kyudo (Japanese archery) experience" that is perfect even for beginners at an actual Kyudo dojo.

- STEP.1 Put on your Kyudo uniform and learn about Kyudo.
- STEP.2 Take part in hands-on practice after learning how to shoot an arrow.
- STEP.3 You can watch your instructor's demonstration up close.
- STEP.4 You can also take photos and make some happy memories.
